Current opening for 1-2 clinical psychologists who are already licensed to practice in IL, but will consider postdoctoral fellows, especially if they have completed their APA-approved internship in a university, hospital, clinic setting treating anxiety and OCD. Supervision towards licensure can be provided for postdocs.

The ideal candidate ...

- Has a passion for treating anxiety and/or OCD, and there's opportunity for the right candidate to start and run an OCD department within the practice.
- Is comfortable working with both children/adolescents and adults, but we will also consider candidates who want to focus on just one age population.

Why ATSA?

- We are results driven, not numbers driven. If you do your best work holding 35 patient sessions per week - by all means go for it. There are plenty of people who need help! However, if you are like us and do your best work holding less than that, please do; you decide the size of your caseload.
- Having a manageable caseload allows room for continued professional development, including pursuing practice certifications (e.g., PCIT-SM, IOCDF BTTI, SPACE, [insert *your* dream certification here]) and board certifications (e.g., ABPP). If you are an early career psychologist, you will receive mentorship and support to pursue your ABPP. If you are an advanced clinician, but never went for your ABPP, it's not too late. ATSA will support you in the endeavor. If you are ABPP, there is opportunity for you to mentor others.
- We run intensive exposure therapy programs, both as individual and group treatments, for selective mutism, and there is opportunity to develop/run similar programs for other anxiety conditions.
- We value the integration of science and practice and, towards that end, support you by subsidizing registration fees to attend national conferences such as ADAA, ABCT, SMA, IOCDF so that you can stay informed of research and practice.
- Because we value research, we collect data on our clinical programs, giving you the opportunity to conduct research on existing data or become inspired to run new data collection/investigations.
- We have ongoing relationships with local graduate programs and wonderful graduate students who are eager to assist with research studies or pursue clinical externships at ATSA, providing opportunities to train the next generation of psychologists.
- We have ongoing relationships with area public and private schools (Pre-K through High School) where there is opportunity to provide in-services or consultations.

- We have paid staff who takes care of billing in house, manages the paperwork flow of new intakes, and overall minimizes administrative paperwork for you so you can focus on your patients.

Required Qualifications

- Completion of Ph.D. or Psy.D. from an APA-accredited program.
- IL License to practice clinical psychology (License-eligible applicants and postdocs will be considered if all other qualifications are met).
- Must have expertise conducting diagnostic intake evaluations for anxiety disorders and/or OCD, and developing evidence-based tailored treatment plans for anxiety disorders and/or OCD.
- Must have expertise providing evidence-based treatments such as CBT, ACT, ERP, DBT.
- Must have a growth mindset and enjoy working as a team!

Additional Preferred Qualifications

- Certifications in PCIT, PCIT-SM, BTTI, SPACE, or other evidence-based treatments are preferred.
- Meeting requirements for PSYPACT APIT is a plus.

Responsibilities

- Provide evidence-based treatments to children, adolescents, and/or adults coping with anxiety and/or OCD and related conditions.
- Provide services in clinic, home, school, or community to maximize generalization and treatment outcome.
- Keep timely progress notes and treatment plans.
- Incorporate parent guidance and/or family-based interventions in treatment.
- Ability to provide in-person and telehealth services as an option for patients.
- Collaborate with our clinicians to develop and facilitate group therapies.
- Communicate with collaterals (e.g., psychiatrist, school social worker, school teacher) as needed.
- Provide clinical supervision to graduate masters and doctoral trainees.

Professional Development Opportunities:

- Training, supervision, and/or collaboration to support professional development as an anxiety specialist.
- Collegial support to follow your interests/further develop your specialty.
- Flexible schedule that you create yourself to support your work-life balance. This includes you deciding how many patient sessions you hold per week.
- Opportunity to become PCIT-SM certified.
- Opportunity to become BTTI certified.
- Opportunity to become SPACE certified.

Compensation and Benefits:

- Private pay, fee-for-service practice means you are paid reliably. Pay range is \$97.50 - \$187.50 per hour.
- Medical, Dental, and Vision Insurance
- Mileage reimbursement
- Reimbursement for continued professional development (e.g., conferences, certifications).
